- Leadership awareness without disrupting responder workflows

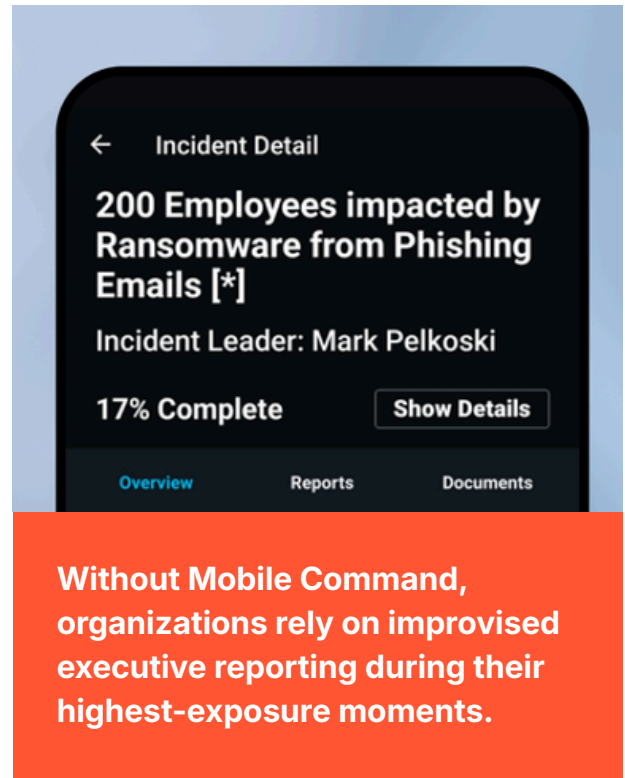

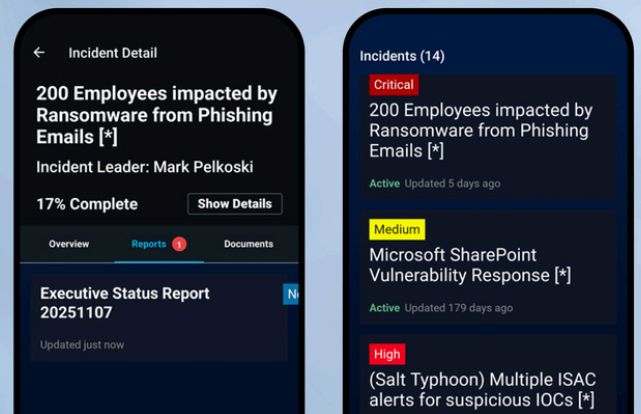
Executive Visibility Without Disrupting Incident Response Team Operations

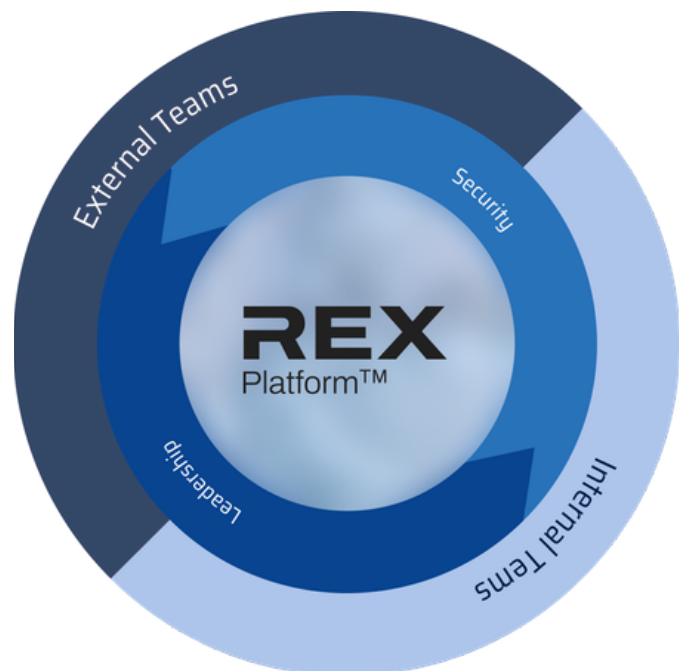
